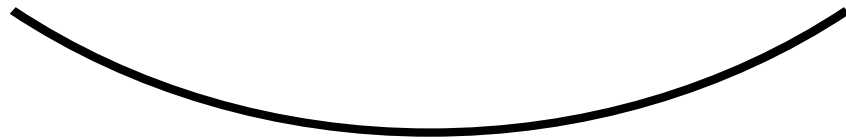


*A walk through history and art in

Welcome to Reggio Calabria, dear friend. How are you?



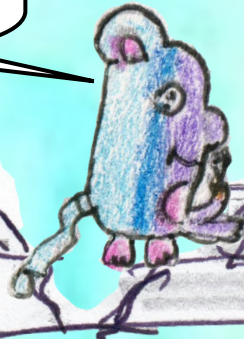
Yes, let's go!

some traces of Reggio's ancient past.



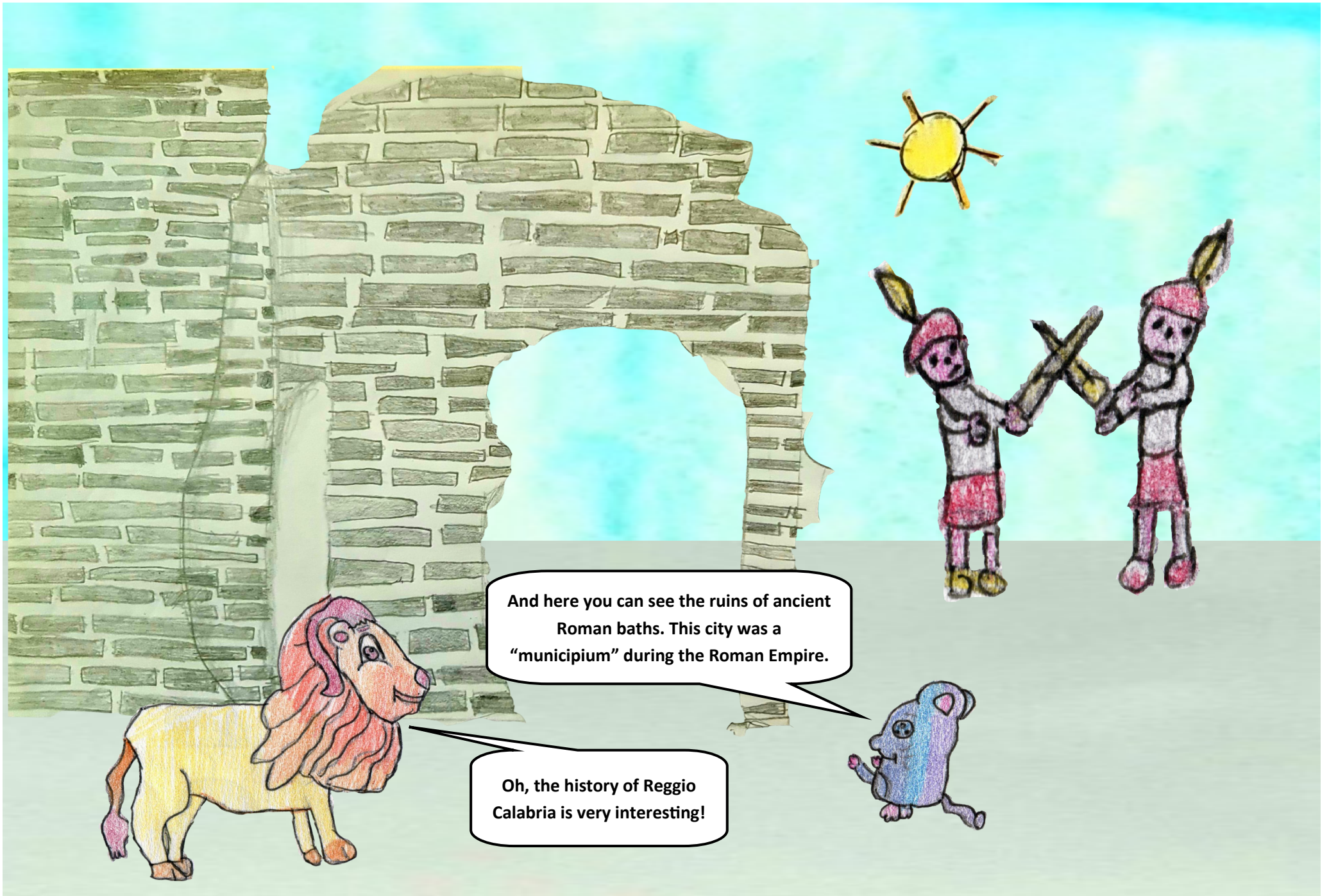


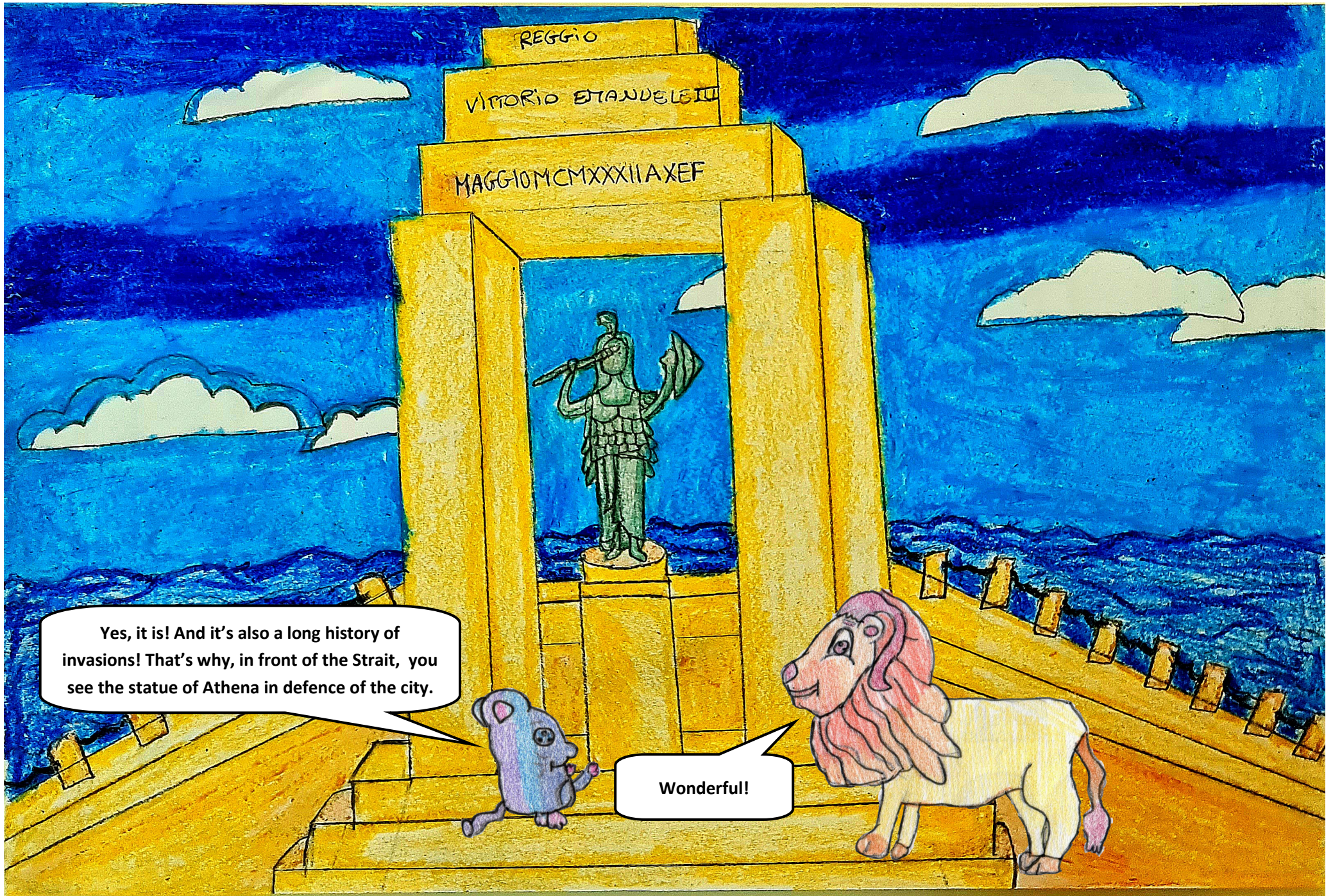
Look! These are really ancient! They're the ruins of Greek walls. Reggio Calabria was one of the first Greek colonies in the south of Italy.



Really? I didn't know!



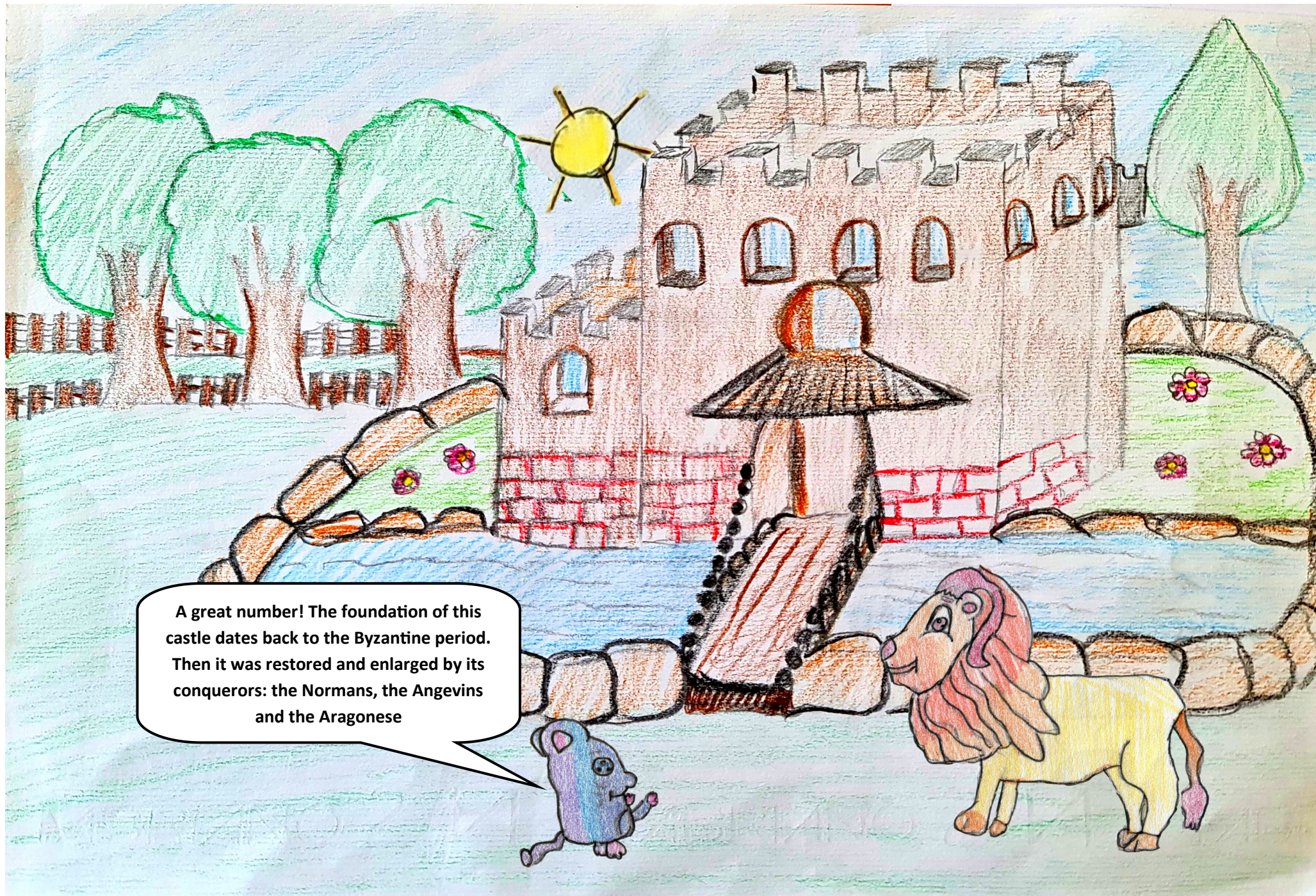






It's really impressive! I wonder how many battles were fought under these walls.

A great number! The foundation of this castle dates back to the Byzantine period. Then it was restored and enlarged by its conquerors: the Normans, the Angevins and the Aragonese

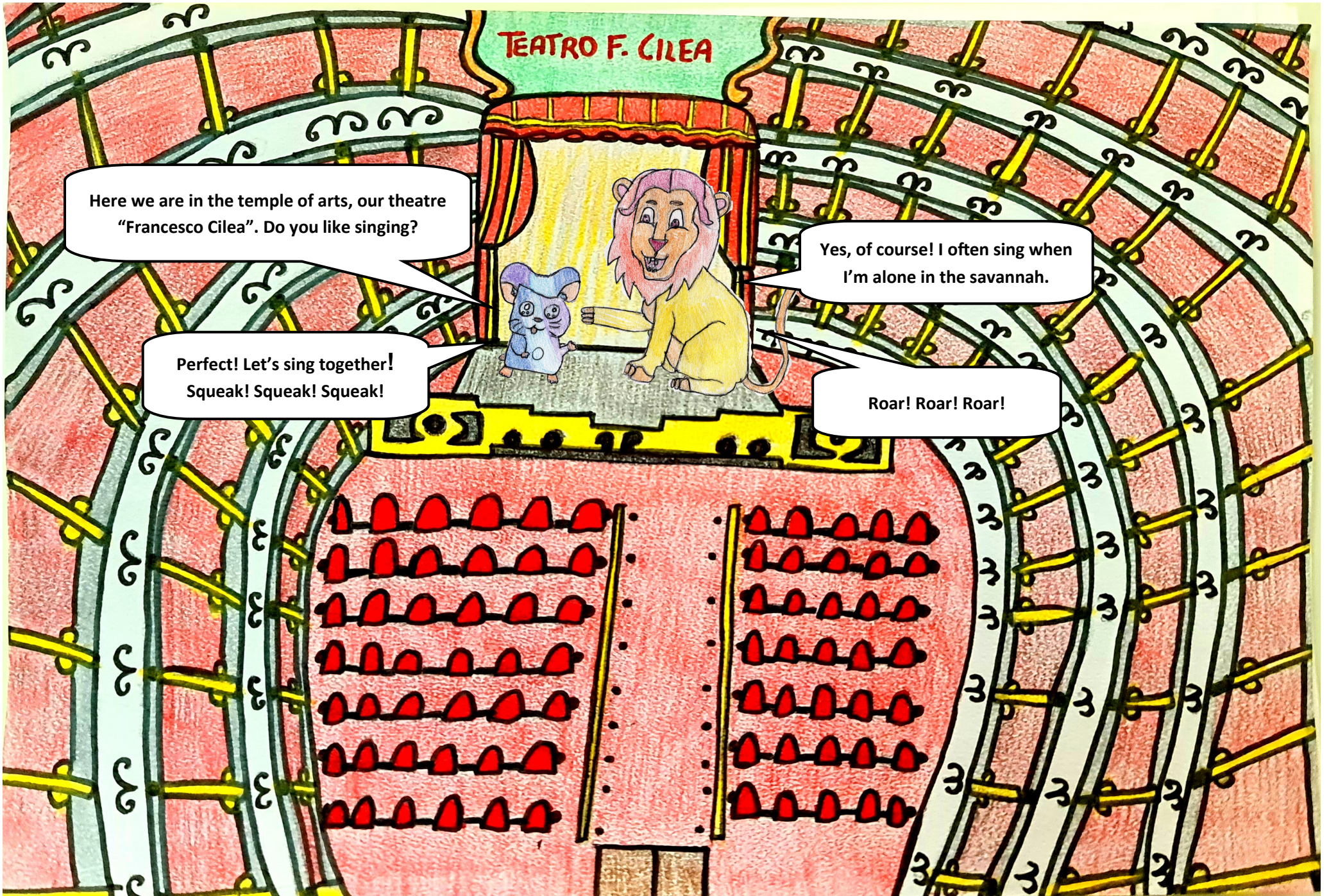
TEATRO F. CILEA

So it's time for a refreshing ice cream in a historic place, Cesare's! It's the most beloved ice cream shop in Reggio Calabria.

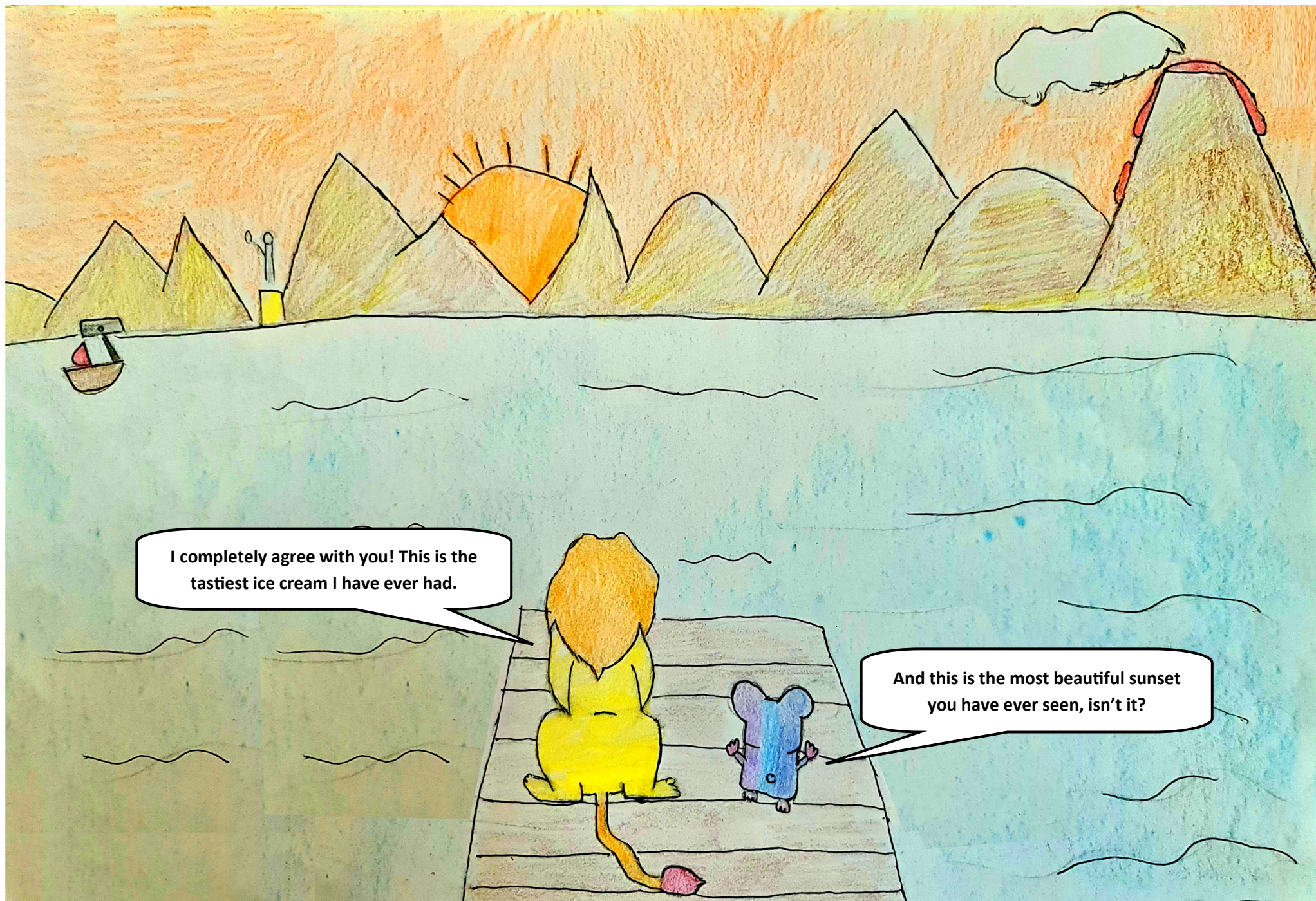
Yummy! This ice cream is absolutely delicious!
