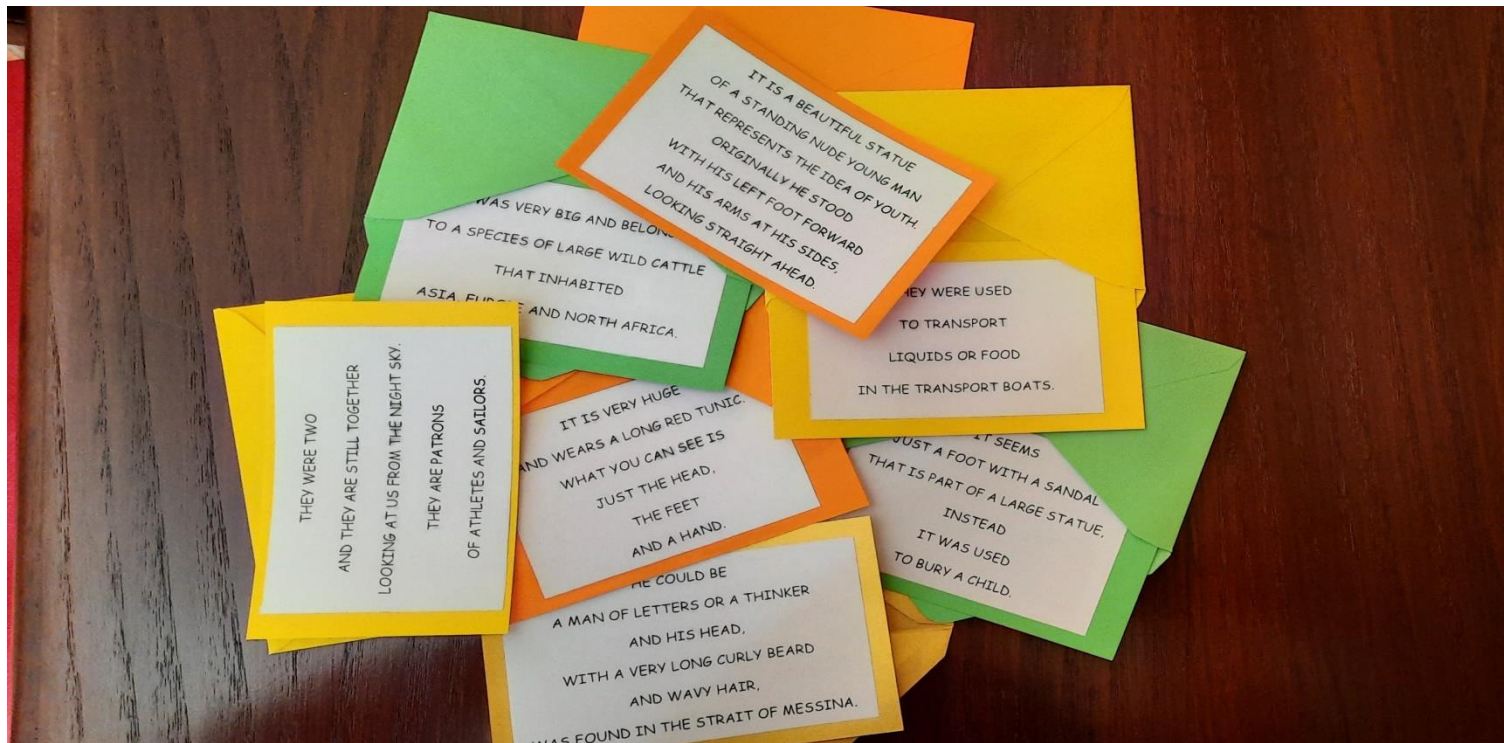


A “TREASURE HUNT” inside the MArRC of Reggio Calabria





These students are the players of the TREASURE HUNT. Their visit to the museum is the occasion to play the game inside the site. Divided into two teams, the students are searching for the **clues** hidden along the exhibition itinerary. Each clue contains a riddle whose solution tells the players where to find the next clue. The final clue leads to the “**treasure**”.

BOS PRIMIGENIUS

- IT WAS VERY BIG AND BELONGED TO A SPECIES OF LARGE WILD CATTLE THAT INHABITED ASIA, EUROPA AND NORTH AFRICA.



DIOSCURI

- THEY WERE TWO AND THEY ARE STILL TOGETHER LOOKING AT US FROM THE NIGHT SKY. THEY ARE PATRONS OF ATHLETES AND SAILORS.



APOLLO STATUE

- IT IS VERY HUGE AND WEARS A LONG RED TUNIC. WHAT YOU CAN SEE IS JUST THE HEAD, THE FEET AND A HAND.



A FOOT-SHAPED SARCOPHAGUS

- IT SEEMS JUST A FOOT WITH A SANDAL THAT IS PART OF A LARGE STATUE, INSTEAD IT WAS USED TO BURY A CHILD.



THE HEAD OF THE PHILOSOPHER

- HE COULD BE A MAN OF LETTERS OR A THINKER AND HIS HEAD, WITH A VERY LONG CURLY BEARD AND WAVY HAIR, WAS FOUND IN THE STRAIT OF MESSINA.



KOUROS

- IT IS A BEAUTIFUL STATUE OF A STANDING NUDE YOUNG MAN THAT REPRESENTS THE IDEA OF YOUTH. ORIGINALLY HE STOOD WITH HIS LEFT FOOT FORWARD AND HIS ARMS AT HIS SIDES, LOOKING STRAIGHT AHEAD.



TRANSPORT AMPHORAE

- THEY WERE USED TO TRANSPORT LIQUIDS OR FOOD IN THE TRANSPORT BOATS.
